

Shamrock Dish Cloth



Crocheted Shamrock Dish Cloth Pattern:

Materials:

White Bernat Cotton Wool
Green Bernat Cotton Wool
Crochet Hook # 5 mm

1. Chain 27
2. Skip 1st stitch, sc in each stitch to end (26 sc), ch 1, turn
3. Working from [Graph](#) from right to left – sc 7 rows, then on 8th row (right side) of work, start following graph. *Each square on the graph = 1 sc. *
4. Follow the graph, ending with 7 rows of sc in white.
5. Finished size – about 7.5 inches. You may need to add extra rows of plain white at the top to ensure that the dish cloth is square.
6. Finish off the wrong side. I do this by using a darning needle and pulling the ends through the stitches, of the same color.

Tips:

Do not carry wool over when changing colors. It is best if you have a small amount of each color, so you can just pick up the color as you go – ie white, green, white, green and then white.

When changing from one color to the next, on the last sc of the old color, finish the stitch off with the new color and pull the old color wool to the front of the work (facing you), so that when you come back to it, it will be in the back of the work.
